7 The Flood

Now, Welcome back to Genesis: Genesis Chapter 8.

Now let's turn to the Scripture:

1 And God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the cattle that [was] with him in the ark: and God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters asswaged;

God remembered = marked, recognized. 기억하셨다 = 인식하셨다

God remembers everything that He has said. ² 하나님은 말씀하신 모든 것을 기억하십니다.

Asswaged: = weave, abate, pacify. 줄어들다, 진정되다

2 The fountains also of the deep and the windows of heaven were stopped, and the rain from heaven was restrained;

Fountains: spring. Source [of water]. 샘, 근원 Windows of heaven: lattice of the sky.

하늘의 창: 격자모양의 하늘

Rain: shower. \Box

3 And the waters returned from off the earth continually: and after the end of the hundred and fifty days the waters were abated.

Waters returned; continually: Here we have drainage. Because of gravity, water runs downhill. If you want to be a plumber, you have to remember that.

⁴ Have you ever considered that God formed the world during the Flood for a specific purpose. The ground and sea 'chokepoints' of the world were formed by God to determine times and bounds. These chokepoints along with drainage affect weather patterns, seasons, and their impact.

Reference (Ref): Act 17:24 God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that he is Lord of heaven and earth, dwelleth not in temples made with hands; Act 17:25 Neither is worshipped with men's hands, as though he needed any thing, seeing he giveth to all life, and breath, and all things; Act 17:26 And hath made of <u>one</u> <u>blood</u> all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the earth, and hath determined the **times** before appointed, and the **bounds** of their habitation;

Waters decreased: So you have a measured

Here we see the term 'forty days' again. ⁶ "사십일" 이라는 단어가 다시 등장합니다.

Window: perforated. 창: 구멍이 있는

7 And he sent forth a raven, which went forth to and fro, until the waters were dried up from off the earth.

Raven: grow dusky, sundown, a [scavenger] bird. 거무스름한, 해질녘, 썩은 고기를 먹는 새

To and fro: ⁷ 여기 저기

8 Also he sent forth a dove from him, to see if the waters were abated from off the face of the ground;

Dove = effervescence, intoxication; [from their warmth of mating]. ⁸ 비둘기 = 발포(거품이 남) 흥분, 취함, 중독 (열심히 짝짓기 할 때)

9 But the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the ark. for the waters [were] on the face of the whole earth: then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark.

Ravens are scavengers. 까마귀는 썩은 고기를 먹는 새입니다.

After the flood, there probably are carcasses of animals, dinosaurs, whales etc; floating around on the water to land on/[and dine on]. 홍수 이후, 아마도 짐승들, 공룡들, 고래들의 사체가 물 위를 떠다녔을 것입니다.

Perhaps, that is why the Ravens did not return. 그래서 아마도 까마귀가 돌아오지 않았을 겁니다.

The dove is <u>not</u> a scavenger. 비둘기는 죽은 고기를 먹는 새가 아닙니다.

The dove returned. 비둘기는 돌아왔습니다.

10 And he stayed yet other seven days; and again he sent forth the dove out of the ark;



11 And the dove came in to him in the evening; and, lo, in her mouth [was] an olive leaf pluckt off: so Noah knew that the waters were abated from off the earth.

Olive [prominent, brightness, illuminating oil] leaf: 올리브 (걸출한, 밝음, 밝히는 기름)

What does an olive branch represent today?

Our house-owner in Italy used to say that all cooking recipes start with Olive oil, and continue with onion, garlic, salt and pepper. 이탈리아에 있는 우리 집 주인은 자기의모든 요리는 올리브 기름으로 시작해서양파, 마늘, 소금, 후추가 들어간다고합니다.

1. Language is a custodian of culture.

Seven; minus one: 일곱 빼기 하나

This is an interesting concept. 이건 재미있는 개념입니다.

[If you want something (and your sins are confessed up) –Give something.]

Little boy who shared his lunch (5 Five loaves, 2 fishes (Melchi)) –fed 5000 [15,000].

Noah builded an altar. 노아는 제단을 쌓았습니다.

- This is the first use of the word altar in the Bible. 성경에서 제단이라는 단어가 처음 사용된 곳입니다.
- Altar = [a place to] to slaughter an animal in sacrifice [to God]. 제단 = 짐승을 잡아 희생물로 하나님께 드리는 곳

Noah gave an offering. 노아가 헌물을 드렸습니다.

An offering is where we return unto God what He has already blessed us with. 헌물은 하나님께서 이미 우리에게 복 주신 것을 하나님께 돌려 드리는 것입니다.


God desires our heart-felt worship. 하나님은 우리의 마음이 담긴 예배를 바라십니다.

In the economy of a local church: 지역교회의 헌금 We have tithing – a tenth of what we gross. 십일조를 드립니다 – 거둔 것의 십 분의 일

We have love offerings. 사랑의 헌금을 드립니다.

We also give to Missions. 선교를 위해서도 드립니다.

Giving is a topic of *future* lessons. I am simply introducing them here today.] 헌금은 나중에 다시 말씀드릴 주제인데, 오늘을 소개만 드립니다.



If you want God to bless your family; bring your tithe to the Local church. 하나님께서 여러분의 가족에게 복 주시기를 바란다면, 십일조를 지역교회에 드리시기 바랍니다.

- 2. Get baptized by immersion. 침례를 받고

Now back to Genesis. 창세기로 돌아갑니다.

21 And the LORD smelled a sweet savour; and the LORD said in his heart, I will not again curse the ground any more for man's sake; for the imagination of man's heart [is] evil from his youth; neither will I again smite any more every thing living, as I have done.

God can smell! 하나님은 냄새를 맡으실 수 있습니다!

[These are decent word studies ... smelled, nostrils, sweet savour.] 단어 공부 하겠습니다 .. 냄새 맡다, 콧구멍으로 숨을 불어넣다, 달콤한 향기

Sweet savour = enjoyable odor. 좋은 냄새

In His heart = heart 마음 속으로

God has a heart! 하나님은 마음을 가지고 계십니다!

[Jesus Christ had a human heart.] 예수님은 인간의 마음을 가지셨습니다

Imagination= form, conception. 상상 = 마음을 품다, 생각하다

22 While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease.

This is a promise of God. Hallelujah, Amen, Praise The Lord. 이것은 하나님의 약속입니다. 할렐루야, 아멘, 주님 찬양

While the earth remaineth [this implies that there will come a day that the earth will not remain.] 땅이 있을 동안 (이는 땅이 있지 않을 때가 올 것을 암시합니다)

- One day the earth will be destroyed by fire. ⁹ 언젠가 땅이 불로 파괴될 것입니다.
- Four seasons. 사계절
- Night and day. 밤과 낮
- Seasons are a fulfilled promise of God. 계절들은 하나님의 성취된 약속입니다.
- Weather is a fulfilled promise of God. 날씨는 하나님의 성취된 약속입니다.
- Sunlight and moonlight are fulfilled promises of God. 햇빛과 달빛은 하나님의 성취된 약속입니다.

Dove ...background: "DOVE. See also Animal Kingdom. Turtledoves and pigeons were the only birds that could be offered in sacrifice, being usually selected by the poor (Gen. 15: 9; Lev. 5: 7; 12: 6; Luke 2: 24); and to supply the demand for them dealers in these birds sat

about the precincts of the Temple (Matt. 21: 12; etc.). See Animal Kingdom. Figurative. The dove was the symbol of reconciliation with God (Gen. 8: 8, 10) and has since been the emblem of peace. It is also a noted symbol of tender and devoted affection (Song of Sol. 1: 15; 2: 14; etc.) and likewise of mourning (Isa. 38: 14; 59: 11, NASB and NIV, "moan"). The dove symbolizes the Holy Spirit that descended upon our Savior at His baptism with that peculiar hovering motion that distinguishes the descent of a dove (Matt. 3: 16; Mark 1: 10; Luke 3: 22; John 1: 32)."

Raven: "The raven, Corvus corax, L., is the first bird named (Gen. 8: 7). It feeds in part on seeds and fruit. To this fact our Savior alludes (Luke 12: 24; Gk. korax). It also captures small creatures alive, but it loves carrion (Prov. 30: 17) and so was unclean. Orientals, as well as occidentals, look upon it as a bird of evil omen (Isa. 34: 11). The Heb. word 'ōrēb, of which raven is the translation, doubtless includes the crows, jays, and choughs, as is implied in the expression "in its kind" (Lev. 11: 15; Deut. 14: 14)."

Olive = "Olive (Heb. zayit; Gk. from elaia). A tree, with leaves of the characteristic dull green at their upper surface and a silvery sheen at their lower, cultivated in all Bible countries. It is alluded to many times in the Bible, often as an emblem of peace, prosperity, and wealth. Much is said of its beauty, fruitfulness, and usefulness to mankind. Its berries and oil are now, as always, leading articles of commerce. Disasters to olive trees are national afflictions, and the failure of the crop is a cause of ruin and considered a sign of divine wrath. The olive berry (Isa. 17: 6; James 3: 12) is a small drupe, of an oblong ovoid shape, green when young, becoming dark purple, then black, and containing a large amount of oil and a bitter element. The bitter, appetizing taste and the nutritive properties of the berry cause it to be a prime food in all Eastern lands. It is eaten after pickling in brine or preserved in olive oil. Only the fully ripe berries are preserved in the latter way. But the chief value of the olive tree consists in the rich and abundant oil that is expressed from the berry. Large groves of olive trees grow in the neighborhoods of most of the cities of the coast of Syria and Palestine, throughout Lebanon and the hill country of Palestine, Asia Minor, Greece, and Italy. The oil produced from them was one of the chief articles of commerce in ancient eastern Mediterranean lands. Oil forms a large element in the diet of the people, being used for salads, which are an accompaniment to most of their meals, and for frying, in place of butter. It is also much used in the manufacture of soap.

It is boiled with crude carbonate of soda, making an excellent grade of hard soap. Considerable quantities are exported to Europe, and the remainder is consumed in the country. The Heb. expression 'ēṣ shemen is of uncertain meaning. It occurs only in three connections (1 Kings 6: 23, 31-33, "olive"; Neh. 8: 15, "wild olive"; Isa. 41: 19, marg., "oleaster"). From its name, it evidently denotes some tree rich in oleaginous or resinous matter, the presence of which is a sign of fertility. It is of a size and hardness sufficient to furnish material for a carved image ten cubits high. It grows in the mountains and has foliage suited for booths. But it is not the olive, which is mentioned by name in the same connection (Neh. 8: 15); it is some fatwood tree, for example, any of the pines. It is useless to seek to identify it."
